Topic: Simple Present

Indicaciones: El Presente **Simple** es un tiempo verbal que se utiliza para describir acciones habituales que suceden con cierta frecuencia y no hace referencia a si está ocurriendo en el momento actual. Por ejemplo: I play tennis. - Yo juego tenis.

¡RECUERDA! El verbo cambia cuando usamos los pronombres en tercera persona (**HE – SHE – IT**), **SOLO EN AFIRMATIVO**, no en negativo ni preguntas. A la mayoría de verbos solo se le agrega la S, por ejemplo: TAKE / TAKES, PLAY/PLAYS. Si el verbo termina en Y, precedida por una consonante, quitamos la Y, y ponemos IES, por ejemplo: STUDY/STUDIES. **Excepciones:** GO y DO, agregamos ES solo en afirmativa. Los verbos no cambian en negativo ni pregunta para cualquier pronombre. Utiliza el siguiente cuadro para ver la estructura en la forma afirmativa, negativa e interrogativa. Presta atención a las letras en rojo.

Grammar Structure

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I live	I don't live	Do I live?
You live	You don't live	Do you live?
He lives	He doesn't live	Does he live?
She lives	She doesn't live	Does she live?
It lives	It doesn't live	Does it live?
We live	We don't live	Do we live?
You live	You don't live	Do you live?
They live	They don't live	Do they live?

swim → swims	spy → spies	mix → mixes
