TOPIC : 2. POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES AND POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

INDICATION: En su cuaderno de inglés escribir a mano la siguiente información, copiar los ejemplos y resolver el Quiz y traducirlo.

A Possessive Pronoun replaces a <i>possessive adjective + noun</i> to avoid repeating information that is already clear.	
- This <u>book</u> is <u>my book</u> , not <u>your book</u> . (Sounds repetitive)	
- This <u>book</u> is <u>mine</u> , not <u>yours</u> . (Sounds more natural)	
POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE	POSSESSIVE PRONOUN
MY My shirt is green.	MINE The shirt is mine .
YOUR Your book is new.	YOURS The book is yours .
HIS His pillow is soft.	HIS The pillow is his .
HER Her dog is small.	HERS The dog is hers .
ITS Its bone is old.	---- * * We don't use its as a possessive pronoun.
OUR Our bird is noisy.	OURS The bird is ours .
YOUR Your house is big.	YOURS The house is yours .
THEIR Their car is slow.	THEIRS The car is theirs .

Example:

Whose eraser is this? / / It's Her eraser
Whose pencils are these? / / They're His pencils
Whose colors are these? / / They're Her colors
Whose backpack is this? / / It's his backpack

POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

EXAMPLE:

The book is mine	This is mine	It's mine
These pencils are yours	These are Yours	They're Yours
The eraser is hers	This is hers	It's hers
The backpack is his	This is his	It's his
These notebooks are ours	These are ours	They're ours
The dictionaries are theirs	These are theirs	They're theirs.

Whose eraser is this? /	It's Maria's	/ It's Hers
Whose pencils are these? /	They're Pedro's	/ They're His
Whose colors are these? /	They're Luisa's	/ They're Hers
Whose backpack is this? /	It's Jose's	/ It's his
